Are We Communicating Our Concerns?



In 2002 the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops addressed the child abuse crisis. Some of the questions they asked at that time were: How had this happened? What can we learn? And, most importantly, can we make a difference in the prevention of child sexual abuse and create a safe environment for children, young people and vulnerable adults?

The question comes to mind, “Are we making a difference?” Thanks to **Protecting God’s Children Program (PGC)**, we can answer with a resounding **“YES!”** There are two primary aspects of this program that have helped to make the difference. First, it focuses not just on the behavior of the victim, but also on the behavior of a child sexual predator as an early warning signal. Secondly, it provides a concrete action plan that clergy, staff, volunteers, and parents can implement to make the necessary changes to create a safe environment for children and youth in our churches, home, communities and throughout the world.

One of the parents who completed PGC, expressed it perfectly when she said, “The Protecting God’s Children Program has changed our entire life. The knowledge we gained has empowered my husband and me to protect not only our own children but all of God’s children.”
