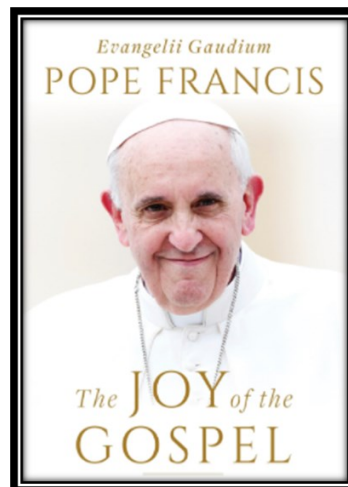
Who are Saints?
