Dear parishioners of Our Lady of the Blessed Sacrament Parish,

I write to remind you that our Mass of Remembrance for June may be viewed this Saturday, June 6 at 8:00 AM and Mass for the Feast of the Holy Trinity on Sunday at 8:00 AM at OLBS.org.

The “Eucharistic Fast” that began on March 18, 2020 and lasted longer than any person could have imagined is hopefully close to ending. The Archdiocesan Task Force on the Reopening of the parishes, of which I am a member, has been working almost daily on preparing to open our parishes once again. The Archdiocese issued publicly the three-phased opening plan. Phase One that has already occurred is the opening of parish churches for private prayer.

The Second phase of the reopening plan is for daily Mass, Funerals and Weddings with safety measures that must be adhered to diocesan wide. When that date is announced, we will email the dates that Masses will begin at our parish. In consultation with the staff, we will decide on which weekdays to begin Mass as a “slow reopening”, so that we can abide by the guidelines. I hope that this will happen during June.

The Third phase is the Saturday evening and Sunday Masses. This phase will be much more complicated with all the precautions mandated in the guidelines. For example, the following will be necessary in the beginning of phase three:

- All attending Mass must wear a mask (except the priest celebrant)
- Music will be limited/singing by cantor only
- No processions in the beginning and end of Mass
- Priests will enter and exit through the sacristy
- Lectors will be seated before Mass
- No Altar Servers
- Exchange of peace can take place with a non-physical gesture of greeting
- No offertory processions
- Collection baskets will be available as you leave Mass
- Communion will be available under one species (Bread)
- Communion in the hand only
- Mass bulletins will be available at door of church on a table
- Priests will not greet parishioners after Mass

These measures are in place for the health and safety of both the laity attending Mass and the priest celebrant. Anyone attending Mass does so at their own risk. Vulnerable, at-risk and other wise concerned persons should remain at home. Any person with the slightest symptoms connected with Coronavirus or even a common cold, you should stay at home and view the Mass on our website.

Additionally, the staff will be working on a system so that we do not exceed the maximum number of persons in church while maintaining the required six (6) foot social distancing.

As you have read, reopening will not mean an immediate return to our practices prior to suspension of public Masses. It is our hope that as time moves on, these restrictions will be eased, and we will celebrate the Masses as they were prior to this health crisis. As soon as more information is available, it will be emailed to all parishioners.

Let us continue to pray that the saving grace of the Holy Spirit that descended on the Apostles on Pentecost will guide us through this difficult period in the history of our Church.
