Online Safety

Just as caring adults have a responsibility to keep kids safe as they learn to cross the street, we have a responsibility to keep them safe as they begin to navigate virtual learning online. For older children, this may involve monitoring the various social networking sites or learning to decipher instant-messaging shorthand. For the youngest user, however, the guidelines are more basic but just as important.

Monitor the monitor – young users should never be online alone. Adults need to be accessible to help guide their searches – or to quickly close an unexpected site.

Centrally locate the computer – by putting the computer in the kitchen or a family room, allows an adult the opportunity to monitor the online work.

Make sure all caregivers know the basics – post an outline so the caregiver and the child can see the rules for being online.

Communicate – children need to know why you are being vigilant as they work online. Explain that not everyone or everything maybe as it appears.

What is the real reason for all these internet rules, and, for that matter, most rules in general? To create a framework in which all children can live big, adventurous lives, safely online. Let your child know that it is ok to come to you with any questions or concerns.
