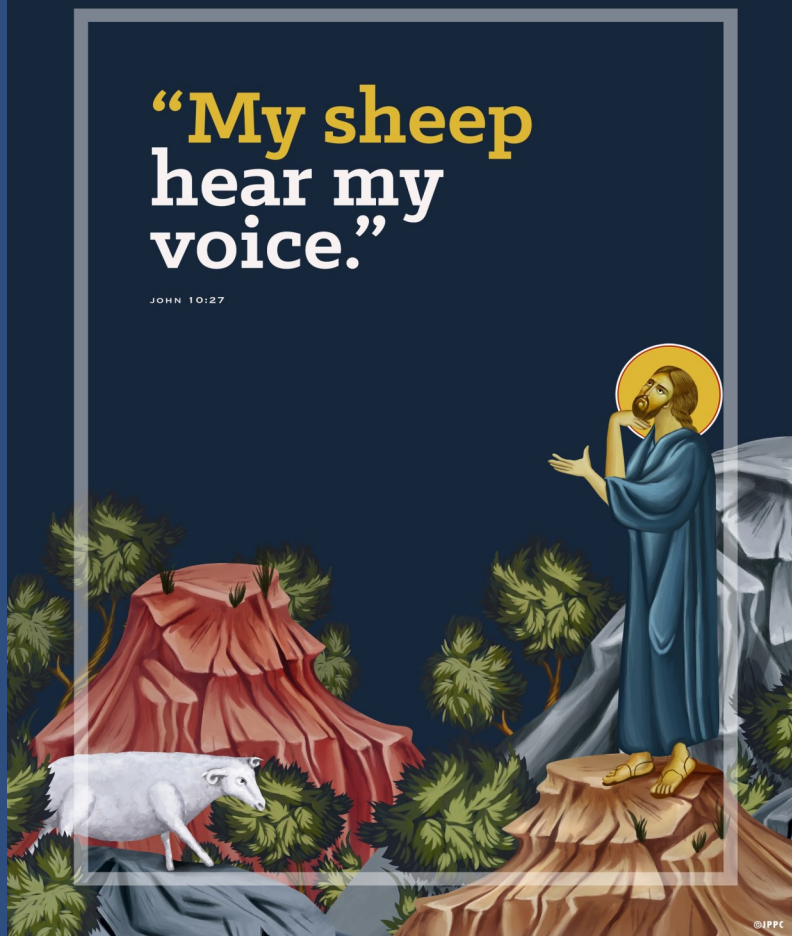

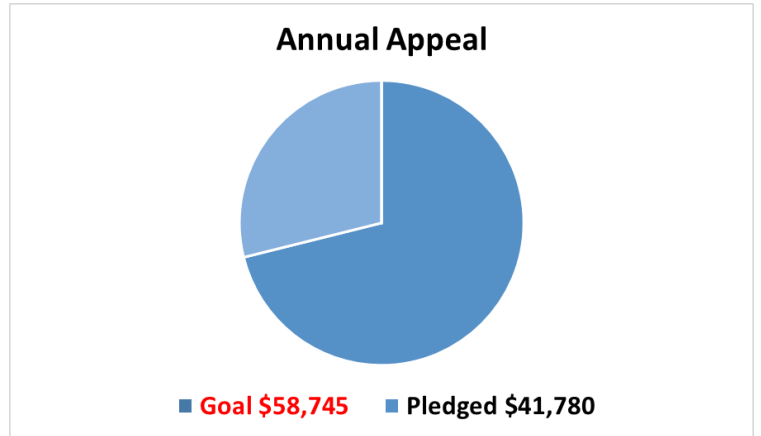
From Needlework's Ministry:
