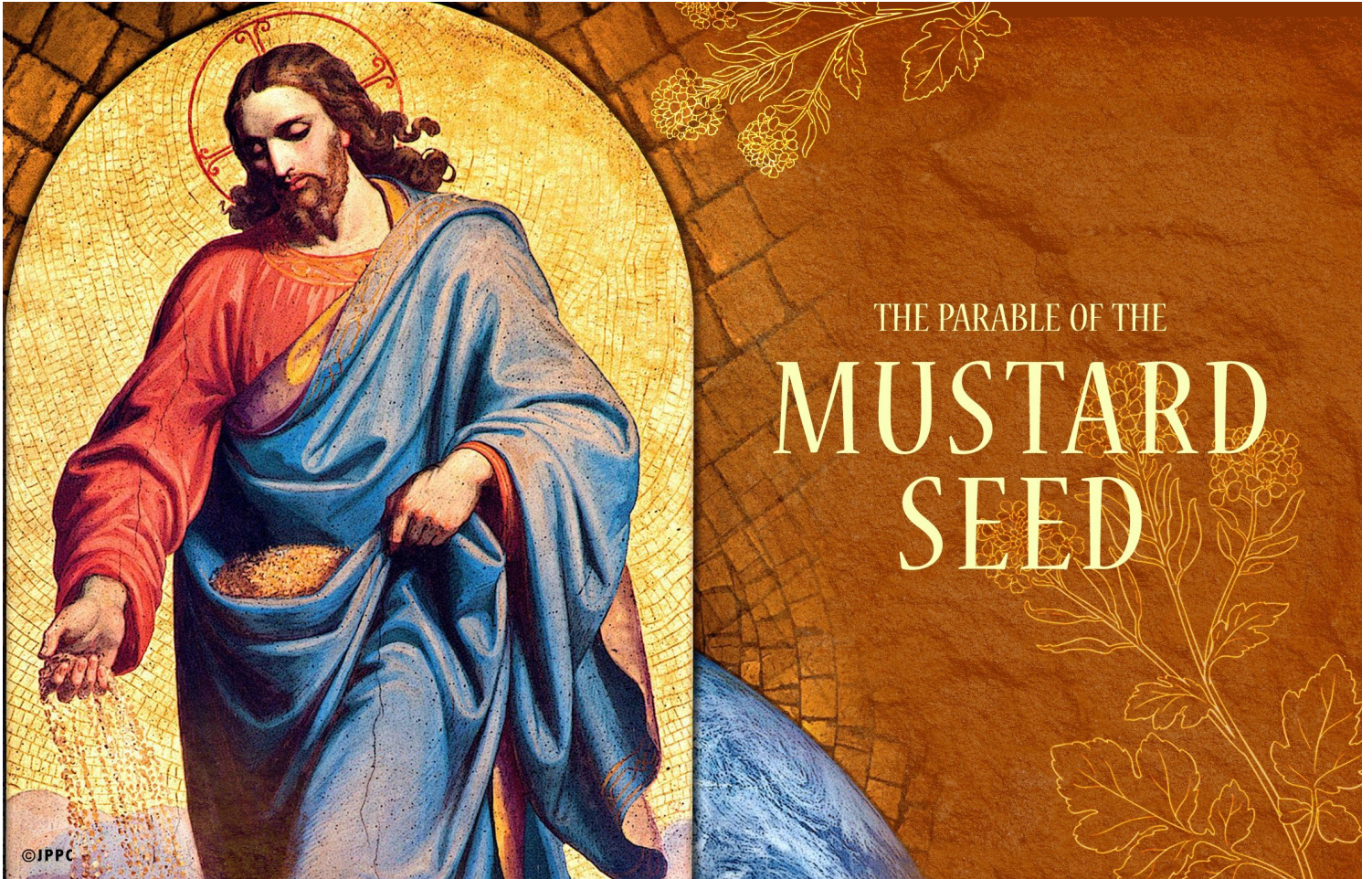

## Music Ministry Minutes



### Why Do Catholics Sing?

*Why do we sing? It's a good question. While the answer to this question may be very simple, the understanding of the answer may take a little while to become clear to us.*

*To begin with, I would guess almost all of us love music. We all have our preferences of styles, performers, groups, types of songs and so forth, but whether we have great voices or not seems to have little effect on our love of music.*

*Music is a part of us, so how does this relate to God and church? Well, let's begin with the reading of the gospel. We really don't just "read" the gospel, we "proclaim" it. When we proclaim something, we use a higher form of speech that declares words in a sort of official or formal manner. We can bring our speech to and even higher level by bringing music together with our words.*

*Proclaimed words accompanied by music stir our emotions, and emotions bring feelings of joy, sadness, fear, comfort, gratitude, hope and, of course, love. Words set to music can help us recall prayers and scripture, but, more importantly, it helps us to better understand the words we are hearing or singing, which, then, helps us to develop a deeper understanding of our faith.*

*When St. Augustine said, "He who sings, prays twice," he definitely understood the double power of words and music together!*
